In 1995, during the height of the Rwanda crisis, two American doctors, Dr.s. Mark and Betsy Neuenschwander of the International Health Services Foundation received a vision from God to start disaster relief teams globally. They visited Malaysia and conducted 3 consecutive Disaster Relief Schools (DRS) in 1995, 1996, and 1997. From these training schools, a group of graduates established a disaster relief organization in Asia. On the 3rd December 1998, CREST was birthed in Malaysia.



+ NEW CHALLENGES FOR HUMANITARIAN RESPONSES

*A Renewed Orientation

A critical shift is underway from focusing on disaster response to emphasizing risk reduction and integrating new technologies and tools to support more resilient and sustainable recovery processes for communities affected by disasters. While we cannot prevent the increasing frequency and intensity of natural hazards, we can take meaningful steps to mitigate their impacts. Compounding these challenges are the growing threats posed by rapidly mutating avian influenza pandemics, which hover at the fringes of the broader natural disaster ecosystem.





*Staying Relevant

The humanitarian system is facing headwinds in a world of uncertainties. Complex emergencies, coupled with funding challenges, exert immense pressure on agencies to make uncertain decisions.

We cannot rely on traditional approaches, but innovate fresh strategies based on evidence, and even improvise new ways of recovery for communities in disasters. Ultimately, it is about making a difference for lives affected by crisis

disaster Amidst these challenges. organizations strive to remain relevant by advancing best practices that effectively translate donors' aspirations into tangible community benefits. Striking a balance between accountability, transparency, and achieving meaningful outcomes remains a significant We encourage corporate responsibility initiatives to shift toward increased financial investment in risk reduction measures, rather primarily offering in-kind donations manufactured products.

*Micro-insurance and Financing in Moderate to High-Risk Areas

The target groups are the lower-income B40 and uninsured groups in Kelantan, Johor, Pahang, Sabah, and Penang. The main characteristics of this scheme are the low premium, small disbursements, or pay-outs, often in installments We are advocating micro-insurance packages as a risk-sharing financial tool for low-income communities in flood-prone areas. This is an exciting avenue of expediting recovery for the poor affected by natural disasters. CREST is exploring this option with insurance companies as part of their corporate social responsibility exercise.








*Benefit-cost Ratio












+ Project Expenses Breakdown by Years
